TUCSON, AZ – The Tucson Association of REALTORS® (TAR) have endorsed Ally Miller, Ramon Valadez and Kim DeMarco for seats on the Pima County Board of Supervisors. TAR additionally endorsed Steve Christy for the Pima County Board of Supervisors in the November General Election.
